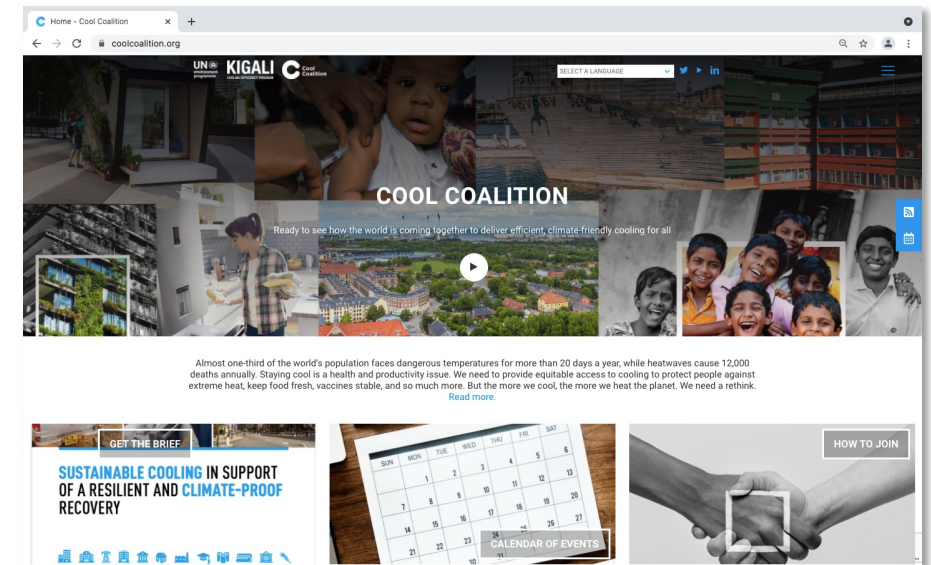
How can a country take part in the Cool Coalition?
